Two \$1500 Student Grants for Behavioral Treatment Studies with Adult and/or Pediatric Neurological Disorders

Purpose: Provide funding to SLP graduate students planning on or completing behavioral treatment studies related to speech, language or swallowing disorders resulting from any neurological disease or injury.

Note: Awards are non-restricted - behavioral treatment does not need to be related to LSVT LOUD.

Eligibility: Domestic (USA) and international applications are welcome. Graduate students (masters, doctoral) in SLP training programs whose university supports research are eligible to apply.
